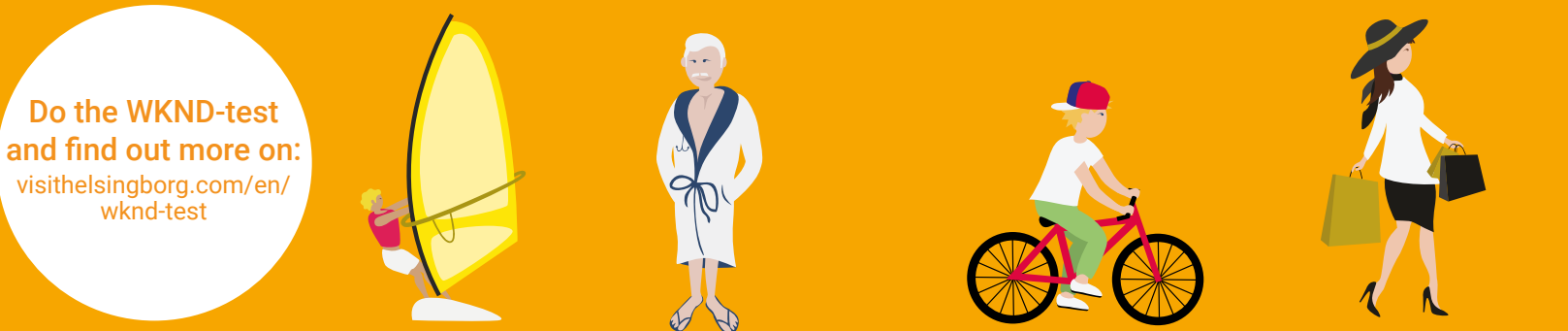
What kind of WKND type are you?

#3 Tropical beach

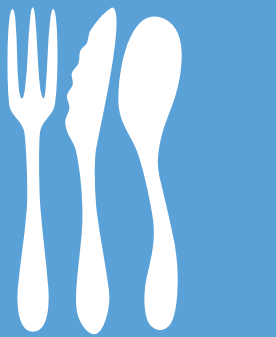

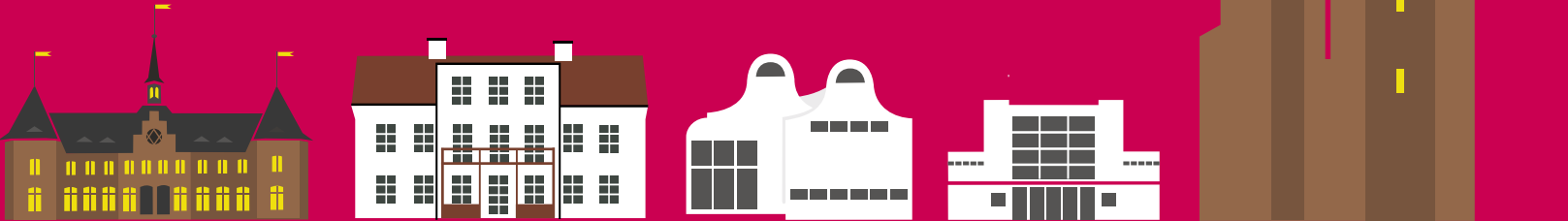
